

# ACTA HALL OF FAME SELECTION CRITERIA

(Amended July 2006)

Nominees must score at least 200 points from the following system and must have won at least three (3) National Titles:

## Points System:

World C'ships		National C'ships		State C'ships
Winner	Runner Up	Winner	Runner Up	Winner
50	20	20	10	10

## Qualifying Championships - Trap Section

- World Championships - DTL and Trap
- National Championships – All Mackintosh Countries
- State Championships - All Australian States
- Events - Handicap, Double Barrel, Single Barrel, Points Score, Double Rise, Champion of Champions, Team High Gun and High Gun.

## Exemptions

1. Prior 1960 – Known Ability
2. Prior 1980 – Nominees must have won at least three (3) National titles.

## General Requirements

1. All surviving ACTA Hall of Fame members must approve any amendments to the selection criteria.
2. Points can only be earned by an Australian whilst being a member of the ACTA.
