

Information regarding Assessments

Re-accreditation of all Coaches will now take the form of observing and assessing the coaching skills of coaches while they are coaching. Using the “Re-accreditation Forms” for either Club Coaches or Competition Coaches, an Assessor will be able to work through the list of performance criteria, and mark off when they are satisfied that the criteria has met the standard required of an individual’s coaching level.

Who Conducts Assessments?

- If you are a Club Coach, you can be assessed by a Club Coach who has had Assessor Training (or equivalent) or a Competition Coach or Level 3 Coach/Advanced Coach.
- If you are a Competition Coach you can be assessed by a Competition Coach who has completed Assessor Training or a Level 3/Advanced Coach.

You can find a Coach who will be able to conduct a Re-accreditation Assessment by contacting your State or National Coaching Director.

(Further information regarding Level 3 Coaches/Advanced Coaches will be made available when the Advanced Coach Level is ratified. In the meantime, please consult your National Coaching Director.)

How do I apply for RPL for Assessor Training?

It is important that we increase the number of Coaches who are able to conduct Assessments. If you have completed Assessor Training in another field, or you have a similar qualification that you believe is relevant, please send a copy of your Training Certificate to your National Coaching Director, who will send it on to the AISL Coaches Committee.

How can I become an Assessor?

If you are interested in becoming an Assessor, and completing the training, please see “How to Access Assessor Training”, which will give you the contact of where you can locate training in your state. When you have completed the training, send a copy of your certificate to your National Coaching Director.

Remote location Assessments

It is possible to conduct an assessment of a coach who lives in a remote location and who is not able to have a face to face meeting. This can be done over the phone, through examples of what they do when they are coaching. This will also need to be verified by talking to some of the athletes they have coached or someone else in their club who has observed them coaching.

Inter-discipline Assessments

It is also possible to conduct an assessment of a coach from one of the other Member Bodies of Australian International Shooting Limited (AISL) – Pistol Australia, Australian Clay Target Association, Field and Game Federation of Australia, National Rifle Association of Australia, and Target Rifle Australia. While the Assessors may not know very much about the particular aspects of how to coach a shooter in that discipline; they will be able to use the theory gained from the Assessors Training to assess the skill level and knowledge of the Coach.

Assessor Training

Assessor Training is available in each State through the Departments of Sport and Recreation.
