### **ACTA/ASSA Junior Initiative**

***A joint venture to promote junior participation for Skeet Shooting in Australia***

***Prize: 1<sup>st</sup> Place \$1,000 and 2<sup>nd</sup> Place \$500***

***Eligibility: Under the age of 18 years at the start of the Skeet Nationals and an ACTA member.***

***Criteria: Any 100 target score from any State or Territory 12g State title of any State carnival. Submit as many State 12g scores as you like and use the best one. Plus the combined scores of the National – Handicap, 20g, 12g and Commonwealth events. Eg: 100+350=450 targets total. Best two scores win.***

***Commencement: 1<sup>st</sup> April 2025 until the completion of the 2026 Skeet Nationals***
