The match will be shot squad system, one target per lane before changing. Broken targets to count. Point score will be used to separate State Teams for final placings.

In the event of an absolute tie for first place at the completion of each State Teams Match, each member shall shoot an additional five (5) targets until a winner is declared.

A Woman, Junior or Veteran nominated in the Open team can also represent the Women's, Juniors or Veterans teams as well, depending on state rules.
