- (c) Angles to be a minimum of 22.5 degrees each side of centre, using a line down lanes numbered 1 and 5 (note 22.5 degrees is one metre outside the line at 50 metres or the appropriate/corresponding hole on Winchester White Flyer Traps, being the preferred trap).
- (d) High Gun shoot offs to be held over same trap settings as applies for competition (ACTA conditions).

General:

Each country to ensure that the rules of commonsense and fair play are adhered to at all times.

No unfair advantage is to be taken owing to the competition being a teams match.

Shooting to be conducted in the normal manner at all times.
