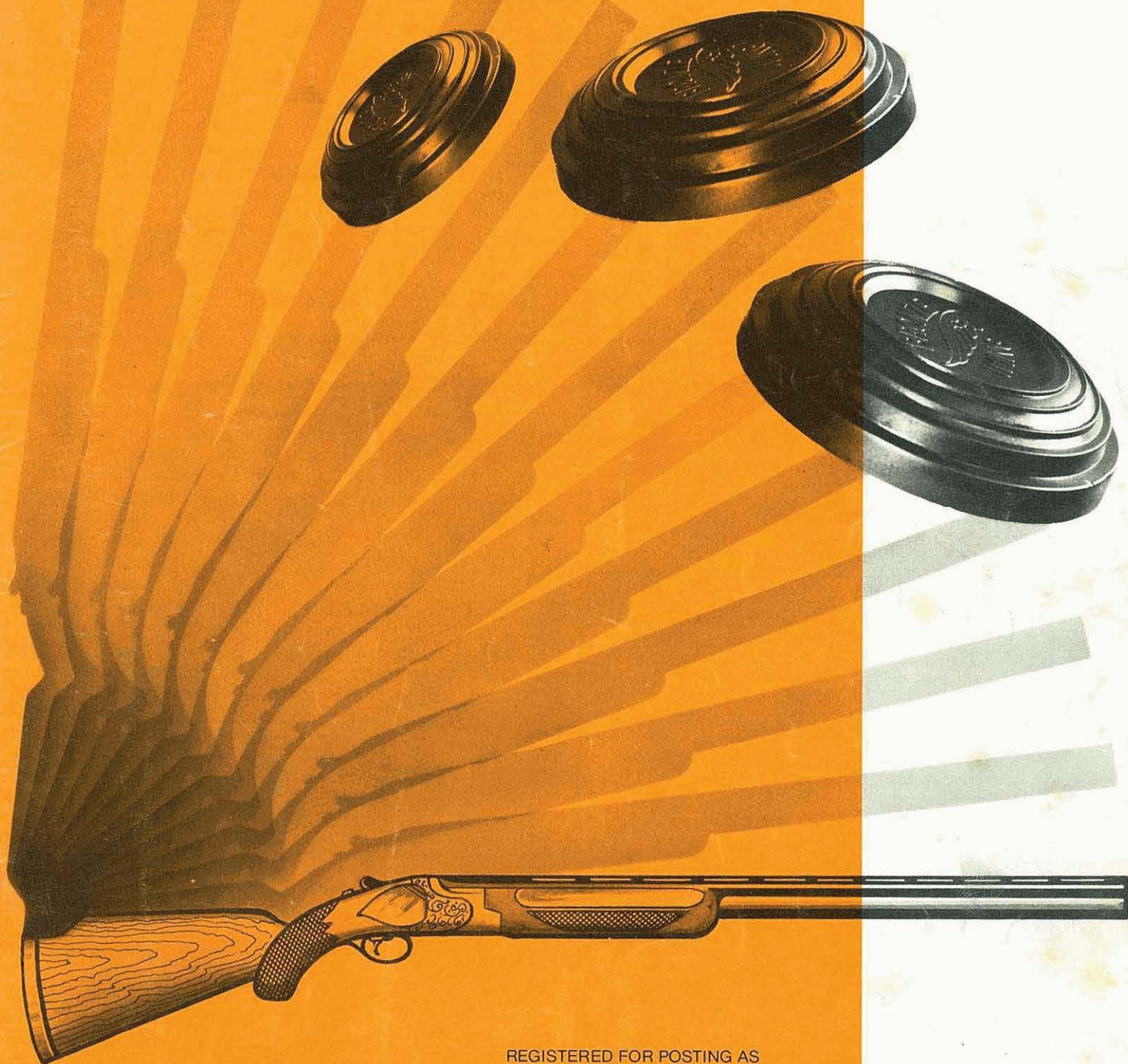

1. That skeet rules 105 (a) and 105 (e) — concerning the Interstate Skeet Teams Matches — be amended to read:

"Skeet teams to be increased from 10 to 15 members with the best 10 scores to count, 50 targets per member in two rounds of 25 targets, quick round method."

2. That Mini Targets be NOT considered in common mark percentage calculations.

3. That the 1975 National Clay Target Championships will be conducted at the Tasmanian Gun Club, Launceston, Tasmania, over the period March 4 to 12 inclusive with events on the programme in the sequence of — Tuesday 4th and Wednesday 5th for skeet, Thursday 6th for Double Rise, Friday 7th for Grand Handicap, Saturday 8th for Double Barrel, Sunday 9th as a Free Day, Monday 10th for the Single Barrel, Tuesday 11th for the ANZ DB Points Scoring C'ship and Wednesday, 12th March for the International Trap Teams' and the Champion of Champions event. A.C.T.A. official travel agents for the period are Ansett Airlines of Launceston and all concerned are advised to make their transport and accommodation bookings as soon as possible with any Ansett Airlines office.

4. That Mr A. Pedersen of Drouin, Victoria, be A.C.T.A. Vice-President for 1974.

DECISION OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

An Australian Team of trap and skeet shooters will be selected to represent Australia at the 1974 ISU World Shooting Championships at Berne, Switzerland in September. The elimination will be held at the Melbourne Gun Club, Lilydale, Victoria on Monday Sunday, 23rd June, from 12.30 p.m. Practice will be available by courtesy of the Melbourne Gun Club as of now and the selectees may be up to four trench and possibly two skeet shooters. Eligibility requirement is a percentage of 90 per cent, or better, over I.S.U. targets. The selection committee is D. R. Taylor (Convener), E. G. Biggs, A. M. Burgess and R. Mules. Team manager will be Jules Steiner of WA.

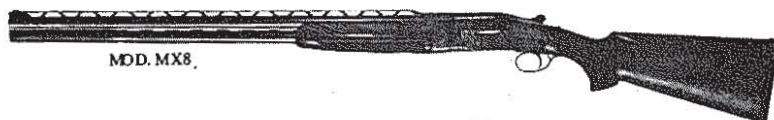

Around the commencement of Cyril's club secretaryship, shotshells were two shillings and ten pence (about 29 cents) per packet of 25 — club price

today is around \$3.20 per packet of 25 shotshells; an ordinary 10 target event was two shillings (20 cents) entry; a 20 target event was up to seven shillings and six pence (75 cents).

Traps used were I.C.I. Plus or I.C.I. Snipe traps, all hand-operated. Clubs in those days operated in quarries, or similar unused grounds.

The first two shoot days of the Coburg Gun Club (now Metropolitan G.C.) were conducted by permission within the enclosed grounds of the Pentridge Gaol. The head warder was a shooter but the inmates were neither invited nor permitted to be present. Most shotguns were of English or European manufacture and had barrels side-by-side, thence, but

around early to mid 1930's under-and-over shotguns were beginning to appear.

Cyril only shot competitively in one event and has great personal pride in remembering that he broke cleanly his first target. He never had time to shoot competitively after that — this fact is evidenced by the "C. J. Colledge Hall" so marked by a special plaque, at the Metropolitan Gun Club, Epping, Victoria.

It was Cyril's original wish that the club visit South Australian Gun Club as they had palled-up with Bob Mules of the S.A.G.C. As time went on, this has developed into an annual inter-club visit both ways, and the feeling between the two clubs is extremely strong.

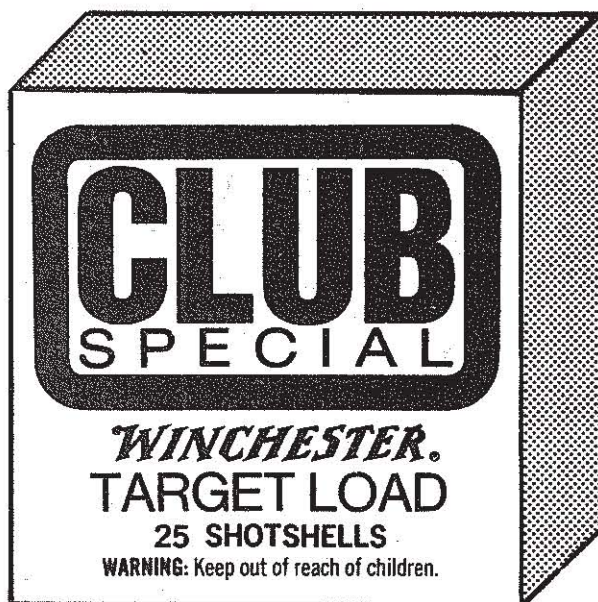

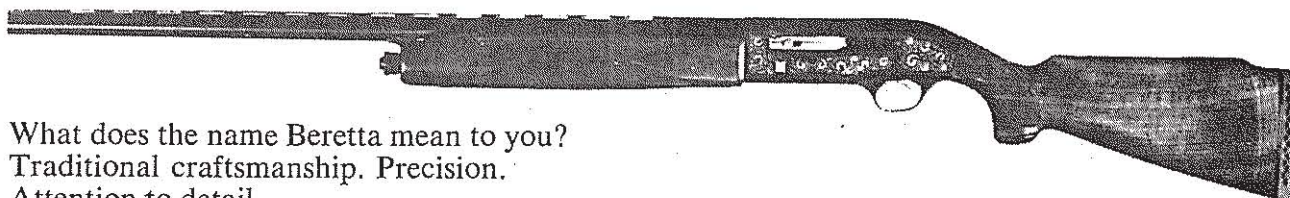

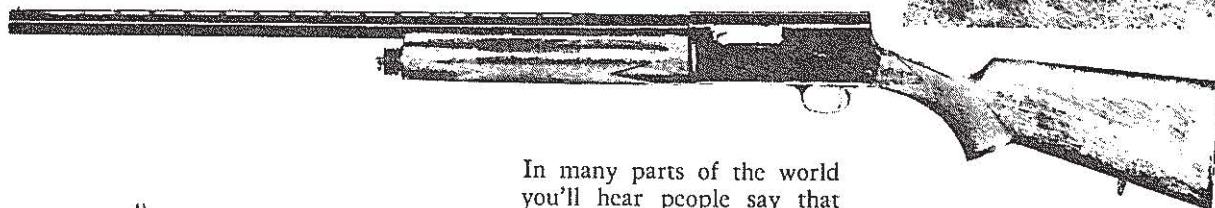
