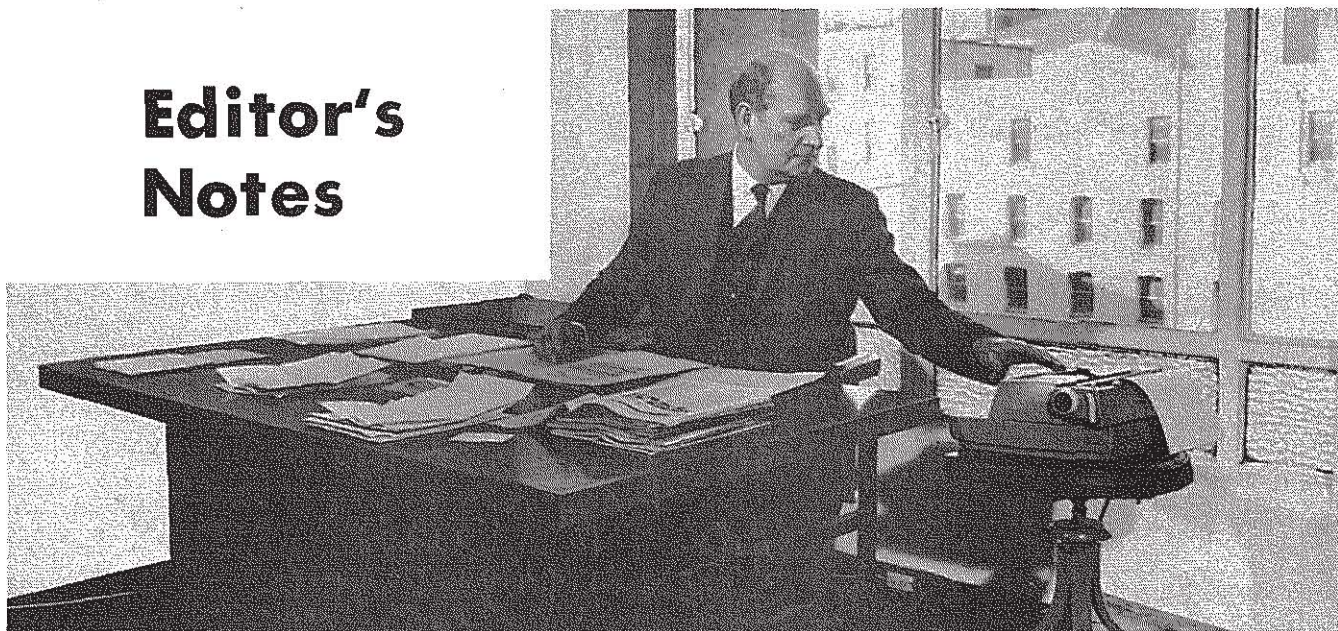

A number of recent reports indicate that the attitudes of some shooters to referees leaves a lot to be desired. Whilst no-one is perfect, the shooting rules provide for clarity of decision in all aspects of our competitive shooting and both shooters and referees alike have some call on redress. This, a sporting recreation in which the participants compete within prescribed and accepted limits and the referees are present and in control of the actual competitive shooting.

These referees provide their services voluntarily and have been examined for their knowledge, aptitude and attitude, as skills, to assist not only the shooter but also the smoothness of the competitions.

However, some shooters appear to be mercenary in their attitudes and, as a consequence, rather intolerant to referees in that they seek to apply undue pressures when at the shooting lanes.

Referees in some instances do change their decisions and the rules provide for this circumstance to a degree of tolerance.

Member clubs are beholden to provide competitive clay target shoots within the desires of the shooters — and throughout the known world — they do.

FIREARMS TRAINING

A number of clubs within the State of Victoria have applied for consideration under the announcement as made by the Victorian State Under Secretary and these will be collated and submitted, BUT, clubs must note that the fund is for all forms of competitive shooting and is not bottomless.

Some of these clubs have asked concerning the A.C.T.A. shooter public liability insurance policy. The situation is that the policy was not envisaged to cover schoolboy shoots, however, should it ever be so, then the policy premium would be appreciably increased.

Apropos the 1974 A.C.T.A. registration list as published in August 1974 "Shooting News", the

following sub-paragraph replaces that numbered 5 (iii) as appeared on page 42:

Shooters may compete in one grade only. At the time of re-registration, or after 500 appropriate targets have been shot at during any year, a shooter may elect to be graded in a class higher than his performance indicates. He must then retain this class until he shoots a further 500 targets or until he re-registers.

In 1975 the club has arranged to conduct shoots during the Easter period. During 1974, a skeet layout was completed despite delays from a prolonged wet season. The electric motors supplied with the traps are still giving some problems however all has been established with provision of easy readiness for transfer to another site when this becomes necessary. A "Gun Club" sign has been erected on Stuart Highway together with other directional signs. There has been frequent maintenance on the "Damo" DTL trap and whilst it still has plenty of life remaining, a Winchester White Flyer with "vertical oscillation" has been ordered to cater for both standard DTL and international shooting. The "Damo" will then be used in a tower shooting installation. The club will then have facilities for standard DTL, international style, skeet and tower shooting.

Discussions with the (Northern Territory) Town Planning Branch indicate that the Francis Bay Expressway may be constructed through the existing Rifle, Gun and Pistol Ranges within the next three to five years, so projected additions to the existing clubhouse have, of necessity, been postponed.

Australia won this 1974 contest by a margin of seven points from Canada.

No complete possible scores were shot by the Australians, however shooters B. Hall of Victoria and S. Marshall of Tasmania, each lost only one point leaving them a common score of 299:300 points.

News and Views (continued)

To whom it may concern — within each of our States, numbers of shooters are showing interest in the I.S.U. types of shooting and some clubs are installing these facilities in addition to their existing layouts.

These forward thinking clubs have found that they attract not only a following from existing shooters but also they are finding newcomers who like this style of shooting.

At this stage Brisbane, N.S.W.G.C. and Adelaide have ISU single oscillating trap systems whilst Melbourne, Hobart, Mildura and Perth have trench systems.

These clubs, and others, have commenced a new style of attraction for newcomers by providing

coaching encouragement from their own personnel. This has been so successful that each club, without exception, has had to introduce practice facilities from a specific trap, not only on their normal shoot days but frequently on additional practice days.

These clubs have achieved successes by forming sub-committees who make themselves, and their services, available entirely on a voluntary basis. These free services have been appreciated by two groups:

(a) Existing DTL and Skeet shooters wishing to learn more.

(b) Newcomers who seek to be a part of this internationally amateur scene.

The special announcement by the Melbourne Gun Club in this publication (see page 17) is indicative of this club's reaction to current newcomer requirements and also to the number of requests they have received from interested shooters.

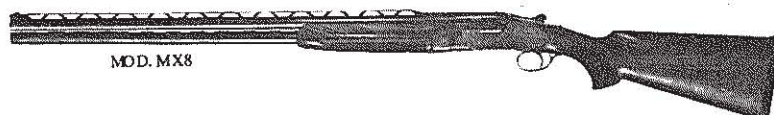
