



To renew acquaintances and also to compete in the New Caledonia Championships some Australian clay target shooters went to Noumea in 1974 and 1975.

The New Caledonian 1976 Championships are scheduled for August 7th to 13th and are available for those seeking to make the trip.

Details are contained separately in this publication.

The 1976 Olympic Games commence on July 17th at Montreal, Canada, and the main group of competitors will arrive at Montreal some days before the official opening day.

The Australian 1976 Olympic Team will depart from Melbourne on Sunday 4th July — the Games are being conducted earlier than previous Olympic Games.

The Australian Shooting Association - of which the

A.C.T.A. is a member — submitted the respective names of shooter nominees, together with their scores. to the A.O.F.

Verbally to the A.C.T.A. then came the information (see page 2 of May 1976 Shooting News) that the shooting section of Australia's 1976 Olympic Games Team would comprise Don Brook and Don Gowland (both small-bore rifle), Norman Harrison (free pistol), Alister Taransky (rapid fire pistol) and Peter Wray (Olympic trench).

Peter Wray, aged 38, of Tullamarine, Victoria, has been shooting competitively at clay targets since his early youth, with consistent success. He first registered with A.C.T.A. in 1949.

Peter will represent Australia in the Olympic Trench section of the shooting sports of the 1976 Olympic Games (the Olympic Trench method uses 15 fixed angle traps with targets thrown 75 metres (plus or minus 5 metres) if measured over level ground and within lateral boundaries of about 45 degrees right or left of an imaginary line drawn through the centre of each shooting station and the centre trap in each corresponding group. (See Olympic shooting Rules published as an insertion within the Australian Trapshooting Rules Handbook). Peter Wray may also represent Australia in the Skeet.

A bi-annual meeting of the Australian Shooting Association was held at Noah's Palm Lake Motor Inn, Queen's Road, Melbourne; from 9.30 a.m. till 4.15 p.m. on Saturday, 4th June, 1976.

Present as A.C.T.A. Delegates were Mr Peter L. Papps (of A.C.T. International Gun Club) and Mr C.

Mervyn Berry (Secretary, A.C.T.A.).
Some of the matters discussed were:-

A suggestion that when National Championship program are conducted by affiliates that consideration be given to inviting an official of the Australian Olympic Federation to the presentation of trophies.

There are flaws in the selection of nominees for teams for Olympic Games, British Commonwealth Games and I.S.U. World championships in the number of selection programs conducted by

each affiliate.

(Editor's note: as time progresses, the A.C.T.A. is establishing I.S.U. grounds in several locations and thus may soon be able to conduct more eliminations. It must be remembered that submissions of shooter names as nominees to the A.O.F. should be accompanied by several sets of international standard scores, established within the period concerned, clearly indicating a personal history for consideration by A.O.F. officials).

I.S.U. World Championships -

(i) 1976 — NIL — as none are held during an Olympic Games year.

(ii) 1977 - September 3 to 18 at Antibes, France

- trench and skeet only.

(iii) 1978 - KOREA - and the Australian Shooting Association approves any Australian team as selected, being accompanied by a tourist group - details to be yet made available.

British Commonwealth Games 1978 will be conducted at Edmonton, Canada, from August 3rd to

(Editor's note: Subject to A.C.T.A. considerations at the time, separate teams may be needed to field competitors in the 1978 Commonwealth Games and the 1.S.U. World Championships to avoid clashing).

Olympic skeet : 100 targets
American skeet : 50 targets

### CARTRIDGES

The cartridges will be sold only by the organizer club. Do not take your cartridges with you, cartridges will be available for purchase at the grounds.

TARGETS

# Practice: 15 CFP each (375 F. each series of 25) ARMS

All the visiting shooters are requested to give as soon as possible, brand, calibre and number of their guns, in order to make easier administrative formalities at their arrival in New Caledonia.

(Editor's Note: Unless shooter visitors send the New Caledonia Gun Club secretary the full details of firearms then those firearms would be impounded on arrival).

COMPETITIONS

From the 9 to 13rd of August (included). The time of opening of the grounds and of the starting for the competition will be dependent upon the number of shooters.

PROCEEDING OF THE COMPETITIONS

1st day—Monday 9th: 50 targets universal trench/50 targets olympic skeet.

2nd day—Thursday 10th: 50 targets, universal trench/ 50 targets olympic skeet.

3rd day—Wednesday 11th: 50 targets, universal trench /50 targets american trench.

4th day—Thursday 12th: 50 targets, universal trench/ 50 targets american trench (1 cartridge).

5th day—Friday 13th: 100 targets, american trench (on the 3 trenches).

FOR ALL COMPETITIONS 1 LADY CLASSIFICATION WILL BE ESTABLISHED (will be dependent upon the number).



### **Wad Seating Pressure**

Wad pressure on AA Wads is not critical.

Any pressure from zero to 40 pounds is acceptable — the only criteria is that the wads must be seated on the powder. (No air space should exist between wad and powder.) A safe level to use is 20 lbs.

### 10 Commandments for Reloaders

- Never load in haste avoid distractions.
- Never smoke whilst handling powder or primers.
- Handle primers carefully.
- Store powder in a cool dry place.
- Never use a powder you cannot identify.
- Never mix powders.
- Never exceed recommended loads.
- Keep powder and primers out of the reach of children.
- Store powder only in its original container.
- Develop a loading routine to avoid mistakes.
