This is the last appearance of the above photograph in A.C.T.A. Shooting News as some two months ago, notice in writing of resignation was lodged by the Secretary/Editor.

More traffic has been processed over the last eleven

years than is commonly known.

Of the Association's member clubs, only six had written constitutions or club rules. The explanations of legal requirements to remedy this, and to safeguard and protect club managements and club members alike, took several years to guide and assist clubs to fruition, with the assistance of our legal advisers.

It has not been completely understood that the Association is a Limited Company, registered within the State of Victoria. The members of the Association are

the currently affiliated clubs.

On numbers of occasions, member clubs have obtained legal assistance from A.C.T.A. records when their

own constitutions have been mislaid or lost.

During these years, National President Mr John Tyquin — an accomplished business executive — was of immense practical help to the association in immediate decisions as to rules and procedures. He was followed in 1969 as National President by Mr Gordon Hall who soon updated the rules into modern word flow and enjoyed the complete confidence and approval of clubs and shooters alike, with his manner, actions and bearing.

Up to 1965, A.C.T.A. central handicapping records consisted only of an annual list of shooter registrations as published in our "Clay Target Shooting News". Changes of handicap were noted on this list by alterations in coloured inks until the next published annual list. These copies containing the lists are held in the

office safe as prized possessions.

At end 1965 a card for each individual shooter was commenced.

In 1968 this system was extended by recording each shooter with both a name and a number but this numbered system was discontinued in the same year by direction of the committee.

On October 31st, 1975, an executive sub-committee decided that a new set of cards be produced and contained on rotary files, with the cards showing a different number as allocated to each shooter. This new stationery and equipment arrived in December 1975 and the directed change-over of records then took place.

On June 25th, 1976, in A.C.T.A. office the subcommittee met a representative of a bulk mailing com-

pany

When the A.C.T.A. Executive Committee gathers for its next scheduled meeting in Melbourne on September 13, 14 and 15, a detailed proposal will be tabled, which a computer company believe can provide a more efficient and economical system of shooter recording which could be operative by December 1976, and, the prog ressive updating of handicap records and the mailing of A.C.T.A. Shooting News.



The trap is a Winchester "Continental", BUT, to cover both night shoots and safety against vandalism, the trap is set within a steel shell which is the traphouse, but, all is hydraulically mounted so that when shooting down-the-line events, the steel traphouse shell is raised by pumping to "X" height, or, if shooting under I.S.U. conditions, the traphouse shell is depressed or lowered. At the end of any day's shooting, the traphouse is lowerd even further so that the trap roof is at ground level. The lock is then placed and the club officials walk away finished with their day's efforts, but satisfied all is well. The main advantage is that this is only a twenty second changeover from regular down-the-line to an I.S.U. revent.

re. GRAND TRAP INTERNATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Following our having sent out preliminary enquiries to all countries in the world which participate in "Trap" shooting, a very encouraging response was forthcoming. Various preliminary arrangements have been made and we are pleased to advise that the Trap International event will be held in October.

This letter is just a short note to let you know the dates. A full program wil be sent out shortly with details of prizes, etc. Awards will include Gold Kruger Rands.

The team events will be contested by four man preselected teams from participating countries. The same or different teams may be selected for the single rise and double barrel events. The individual events may be contested by any shooter in the world on an "open" basis.

The Trap Single Rise "200" bird event and the Trap Double Rise "200" bird event which take place on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday will be followed by a five hundred bird program. Two of these events are International Skeet and Trench, the others being daily 100 bird Trap events. The full program is as per the attached Schedule.

Arrangements are in hand for caravan rest facilities for each international team and for other facilities to make the shoot enjoyable for competitors, officials and spectators.

A meeting will be held on the first practice day at which each international team may be represented by its chosen delegate or team captain. This meeting will determine a uniform set of rules where any discrepancy

occurs in the rules as followed by the various countries. If your country would like to supply a referee or jury member (not being a competitor in the two international events), your association will be welcome to do so.

We will be contacting you again shortly with further details. At the same time we will supply you with information on hotel and holiday facilities, hunting and other amenities available.

A MORNING IN HONG KONG

From Hong Kong Island it's only a short drive up route Twisk to the very imposing Hong Kong Gun Club.

The clubs layouts and facilities have been built on a site which has been excavated from the side of a mountain which overlooks Kwi Chung, the grounds are 1200m above sea level and boast a magnificent view.

A two storey club house with many of the facilities so sadly lacking in their Australian counterpart dominates the whole layout. The grounds are protected by a formidable security fence and five rather ferocious looking dogs roam the premises.

The full time live-in caretaking staff have separate

quarters on the grounds.

The equipment provided consists of one automatic I.S.U. skeet layout furnished with Spieth Traps and a single trap I.S.U. trench which has been converted from a five trap layout, this is equipped with a Spieth Turrent trap.

The Gun Club also caters for those shooters who participate in running boar and pistol and a range for

both is provided.

The skeet and trap layouts are each on a separate terrace on the side of the hill, the running boar and pistol ranges are in a some-what similar situation.

The aspect to the left of the I.S.U. trap layout is the Container Terminal of Kow Loon - 1200m below, to the right the elevated skeet layout, in front is a very deep gully heavily wooded on the far side. Surprisingly enough the trap targets are quite easily visible. However the skeet targets are a some-what different proposition with the high house targets smashing into a rock face just past the shooting limit boundary, the contrast of target and hillside make it a difficult task to bring in a good score.

The club membership which is cosmopolitan at present stands at approximately 300.

Targets are imported from Taiwan and their cost is comparable to those locally produced in Australia.



Club house of Hong Kong Gun Club (portion of skeet layout in foreground).









Mr Ken Lowry is one of Australia's foremost shotgun shooters and, being a most presentable person, has a lot to offer as an instructor.




