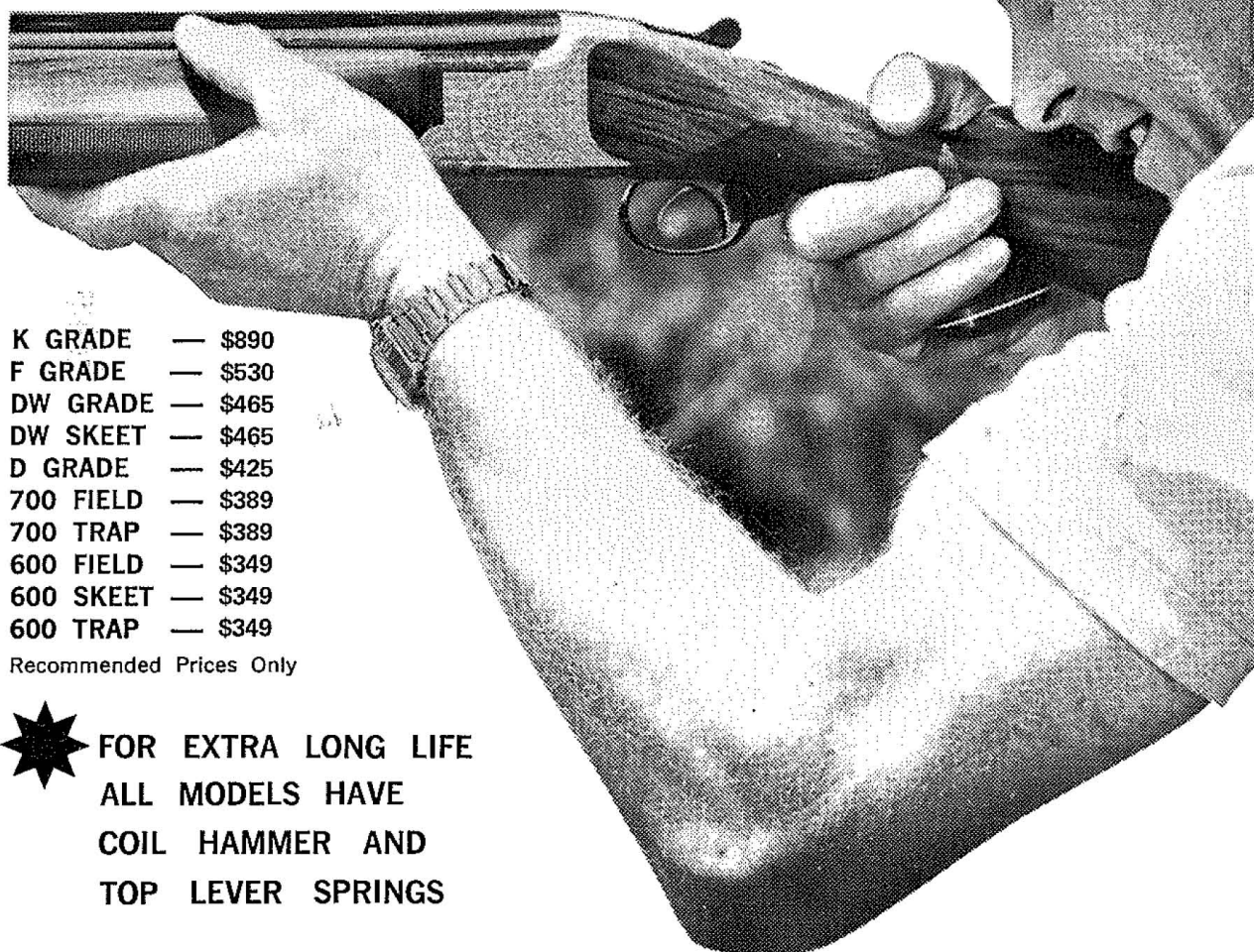

Secretary's Notes

THESE CHANGING TIMES!

Most readers of the "News" will by now be aware of the staffing changes which have occurred in the A.C.T.A. National Administrative Office. Mr Mervyn Berry, Secretary/Editor for 11 years has had to stand down for health reasons, and his resignation became effective on 27 August, 1976. As my appointment as Mr Berry's replacement did not become effective until October 11, 1976, a tremendous work load fell on to the shoulders of Mrs Shirley Pike, who as Acting Assistant Secretary, has performed magnificently. She faced the traumatic experience of assisting the chairman in the conducting of an Executive Committee Meeting and came through with flying colours. The situation was further complicated by the untimely collapse of the National President "Tup" Pedersen four days prior to the meeting, following which Mr Ern Hawkins, at very short notice, took over as Acting Chairman. The team work shown by Mr Hawkins, Mrs Pike and the National Executive is proven by the fact that the meeting went very smoothly and the agenda was completed in two days.

Mrs Pike has managed to meet all deadlines connected with the production of the "Shooting News" although the co-operation she has received from Waterwheel Press, the printers, has certainly helped considerably.

All of this is a hard act to follow. However, it is necessary to re-establish two basic facts — The first is that Shooters, Club Committees, and State Councils are all on the same team as the National Executive Committee and the Administrative staff. In the past, there has been some evidence that it has been "Them against us!" This must change as we are all working to improve our sport. The second fact to be considered is that Clay Target Shooting is no different to any of the rest of life's activities in that the standards achieved are directly proportionate to the quality of both internal and external communications. We must take great care with what is said or written, but we must also accept responsibility for keeping lines of communication as open as is practicable.

In this respect this "Journal" can be better utilized, and it is hoped that some additional features will appear shortly.

The only other promise that, as Secretary, I can safely make at this early stage is that the Administrative unit will continue to endeavour to improve its performance — for the good of the TEAM!!

SHOOTING NOTABLE RETIRES

On October 1, 1976 Mr J. N. (Newton) Thomas retired from I.M.I. Australia Limited after 28 years of service. Newton is one of the very few people in Australia whose name is known to almost every competitive shooter in the country in all disciplines (i.e. Clay Targets, Pistol, Small Bore and Moving Target).

In more recent times, Newton has devoted much of his time to training juniors in the safe handling of firearms, and it is estimated that he has delivered well over five hundred lectures on this subject alone.

Newton Thomas is unique in that he has combined his extraordinary shooting talents with a flair for conservation projects and he has enjoyed a close relationship with both National and State Government Conservation Authorities.

In our field his record is enviable in that he has represented Australia in the "Mackintosh" International Trap Teams' Match on twenty-two occasions, being High Gun seven times. He has held all major National Titles and in 1974 reached one of the high points of his shooting career when he was appointed as Coach to be Australian Shotgun Team which represented us at Berne Switzerland in the 1974 World Shooting Championships.

All his friends in shooting extend to Newton Thomas and his family best wishes for a happy retirement — it is to be hoped that Clay Target Shooting will continue to gain benefits from his broad experience.

I.C.I. PERPETUAL TROPHY SHOOT

Wagga shooter Warren Charlton scooped the pool by winning all three Championships at the Cowra Gun Club's Open Shoot held on Saturday and Sunday, 4th and 5th September.

The feature of Warren's shooting was a very fine 94-94 targets in the Lachlan Valley Double Championship held on Saturday afternoon.

Total attendance for Saturday being 82 shooters in the afternoon and 69 shooters at night. Visitors to the shoot came from South Australia, Gilgrandra, Warren, Dubbo, Bathurst, Orange, West Wyalong, Young, Parkes, Crookwell, Grenfell and the consistent long distance travellers from Bombala and Berridale, Wollongong and Sydney.

Sunday shooting commenced with a 15 target Double Barrel Sweep off 16 metres in which 25 shooters shared the prize money. Attendance on Sunday was 106 shooters. Second event was the Central Tablelands Single Barrel Championship, once again won by W. Charlton 25-25. 'B' grade was E. Bertolin 24-25 and 'C' grade G. Keir 20-22.

Event 3 was a shooters selection Handicap of 20 targets with a total trophy value of \$450.00. 1st prize was won by M. Laughton of Orange 34-34 from A. Lucchese of Marconi Gun Club 33-34. 3rd was R. Lucre of Illawarra Gun Club 31-32. Front Marker trophy won by G. Hug 19-20.

The feature event of the weekends shooting was the I.C.I. Perpetual Trophy which was retained by the Illawarra Gun Club when the Illawarra Blue team scored 96-100, with three other teams running second. N.S.W. 1, Sydney Gun Club and the Cowra Gun Club team No. 1, 93-100.

High Gun trophy over the whole programme Saturday and Sunday was won by Max Laughton who only dropped 2 targets over the whole weekend. Intermediate High Gun was won by A. Dotto, of Marconi Gun Club.

At the presentation of trophies E. Hawkins President of the N.S.W. Clay Target Association, and Vice President of the A.C.T.A. Congratulated the members and committee of the Cowra Gun Club for the excellent manner in which the shoot was conducted, and the exceptional standard of the new amenities block recently completed. In declaring these amenities opened, he said that the Cowra Gun Club grounds ranked amongst the best in Australia, and undoubtedly were a result of the untiring effort of the Club President Len Bird.

The smooth running of the shoot, and the fine meals were a tribute to the Committee, the Secretaries and the Club Ladies.

WORLD MOVING TARGET CHAMPIONSHIPS — 1977

The 1977 W.M.T.C's will be held at Antibes, France, during September 1977. As was reported in the October 1976 issue of "Shooting News" the entry of an Australian Trap and Skeet Team is very much dependent on finance becoming available.

Nevertheless, qualifying facilities have been arranged and it has been agreed that all National Commonwealth and State I.S.U. Trap, Universal Trap and I.S.U. Skeet Championships conducted between June 1976 and June 1977 will be regarded as qualifying events.

In addition to the events previously listed the Hobart Gun Club will conduct a major ISU Trap Championship on November 14th at their Mangalore Shooting Ground.

DOMESTIC REMINDER TO CLUB SECRETARIES

Advertising:

Because of Annual Shut down of Printing Industry, there will be **NO** issue of the "Shooting News" in January. Club Secretaries are advised that deadline for copy for advertisements to appear in December issue is November 1, 1976, and deadline for copy for advertisements to appear in January/February 1977 issue is December 1, 1976.

FEES:

Club affiliation fees for 1977 (\$10) are due on January 1, 1977, and a plea is made to Club Secretaries to include this fee with their first Shooter Registration Return for 1977.

Shooter Registration Fees are also due on January 1977 and your attention is drawn to the revised fee for 1977 — i.e. \$15 (Junior fees are unchanged at \$1 — however, juniors wanting to receive monthly copies of the "Shooting News" must pay the full \$15).

Where two or more registered A.C.T.A. shooters have a common address and are related, then on request, only one copy of the "Shooting News" will be sent and the registration fee applicable to the second person is reduced to \$8. Only current financial members for 1977 will receive the "Shooting News" for April and subsequent issues. (i.e. those shooters whose fees are received at the A.C.T.A. office before March 14, 1977).

Nominations for all offices of the Association close at 5 p.m. on Friday December 31, 1976, and must be lodged on the prescribed form (available from National Secretary) with, the Secretary, A.C.T.A., G.P.O., Box 2038, Melbourne, Victoria 3001.

Nominations must be lodged in accordance with Article 27 of the Association's Constitution which reads: "Nominations for all offices in the Association and members of the Executive Committee must be in writing signed by the Secretary of the member Club or by the Delegate member of an unincorporated club making the nomination, and must reach the Secretary of the Association on or before December 31st, in each year prior to the Annual General Meeting.

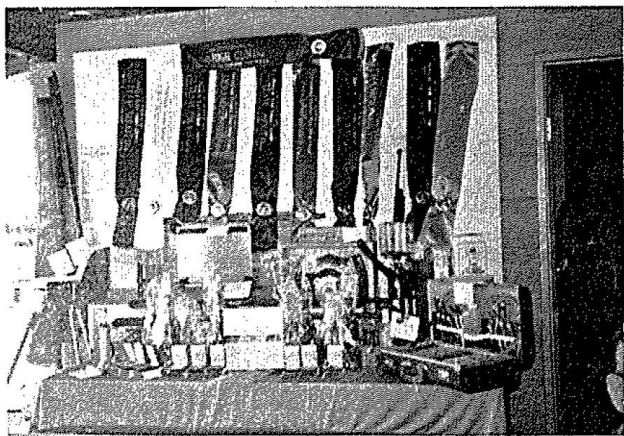

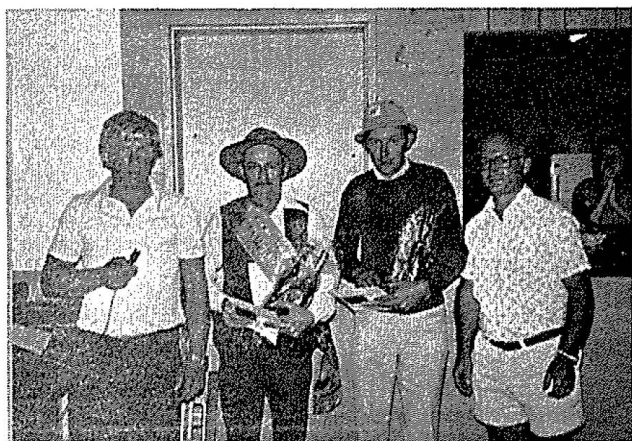

Trophy table and sashes for Winchester & Centenary Shoot. (Medals & wines in foreground are special sporting ones awarded for Centenary Year).



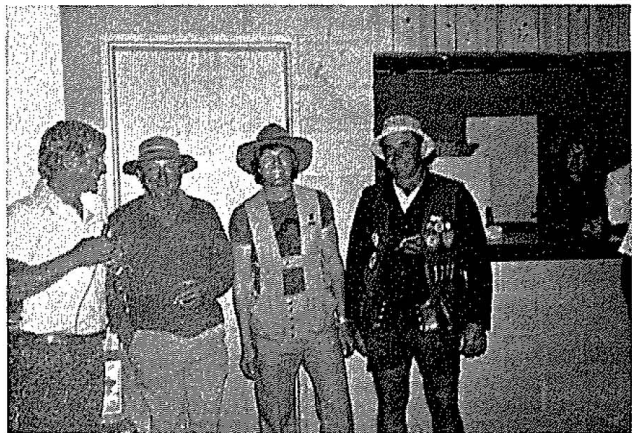

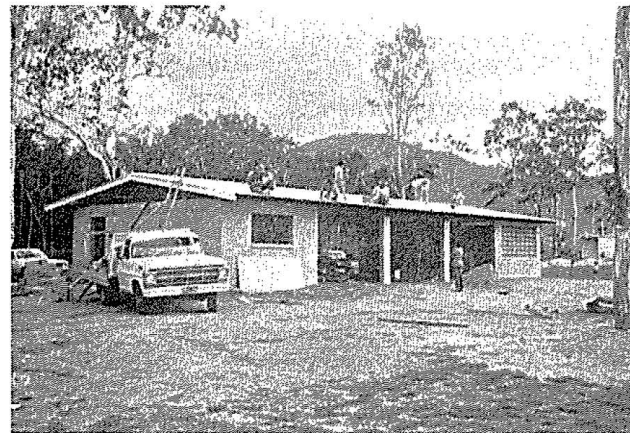

TO ALL SHOOTERS

We the I.S.U. Sub-Committee were given the task of raising funds for our International Shooting trips. We realise that all shooters do not agree that our shooters compete internationally, but we know too that there are a lot of shooters who feel very strongly that they should. We are asking that these shooters interested in International Shooting, for our A.C.T.A. members to pay \$20 per annum direct to the A.C.T.A. with their registrations.

This \$20.00 will go directly into our travel fund for overseas team trips—on a National ISU representative basis.

Only the shooters who have paid their \$20 prior to elimination will be eligible to represent their Country in an overseas team. \$20 is a lot (it's less than four packets of Cartridges at retail prices today) but this is little to contribute to the promotion of shooting in Australia, for without our overseas teams we cannot hope to keep goals in front of our prospective members to join the A.C.T.A.

Our A.C.T.A. shooters must have experience in world competition if we are ever going to bring Clay Target Shooting up to the level that other Australian sports and sportsmen have attained. With overseas trips we will do this, for not only will the members of the teams gain shooting knowledge, but through them shooting in Australia will improve.

How much closer we would have been to those elusive Gold Medals at the World Championships and Olympic Games, if we had started sending our shooters years ago. We have made the start and with your support, and with the great potential of shooting ability we have in the A.C.T.A. we will have those Medals, and a bigger and better membership in our sport.

We are relying on you the shooter who has the interest of Clay Target Shooting foremost in his mind to help your friends see the necessity to have this travel fund working.

Please remember that it is not compulsory to support the travel fund, but also remember that Australian Clay Target shooting needs your support for the Overseas Travel Fund if we are to go to the top, and the top is the place we should all aim for.

One hundred and ten schoolboys attended.

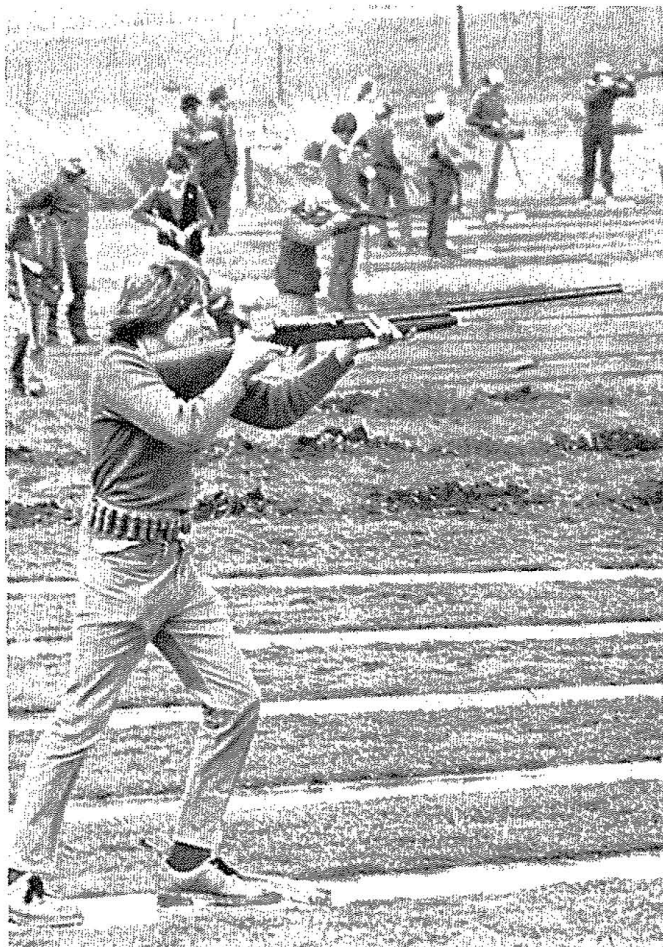

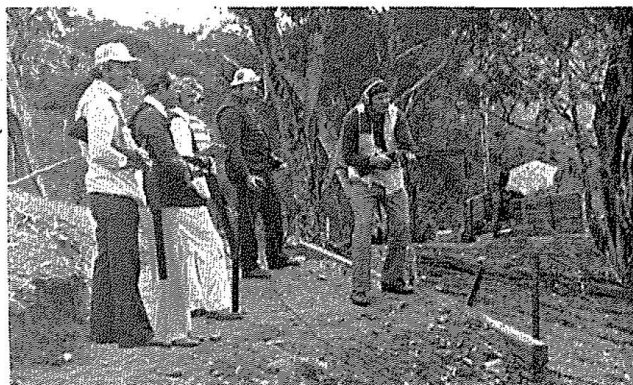

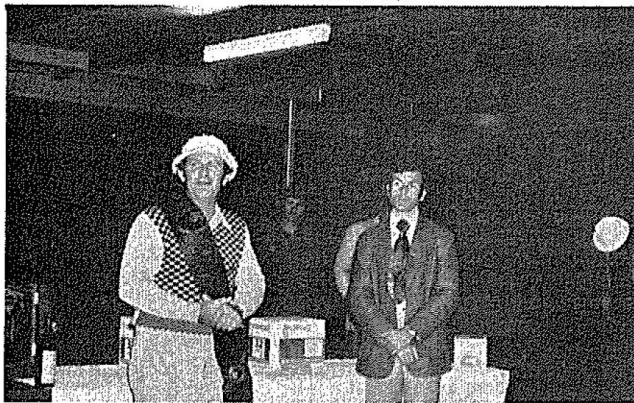

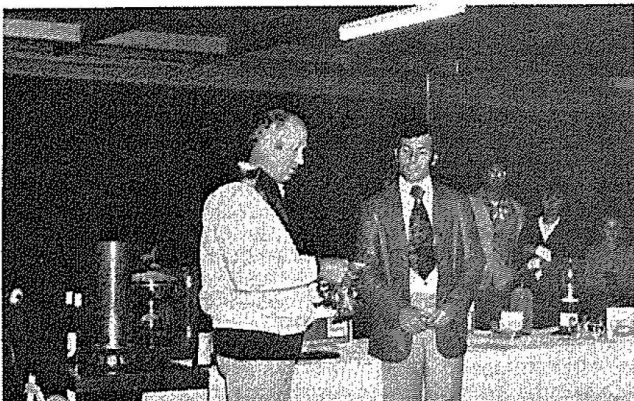
